2012 CLUB RULES

These rules are not to contradict or breach any of the GCR's. These rules are to help members and officials to communicate and help the ride days to proceed smoothly.

- **CODE OF CONDUCT:** All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law –
- **CODE OF CONDUCT:** (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behavior at all motorcycle meetings. This Code of Conduct applies to all meetings held by the Central Coast Junior Motorcycle Club and shall be enforced. All members, family and friends are asked to arrive and leave in an orderly manner so that we do not disturb the neighbors.
- **SIGN ON:** All competitor machines must be presented for scrutineering after rider has signed on. Riders Briefing will be held at 9.30am with riding commencing at 10.00am sharp. No bikes to be started before Riders Briefing.
- **SCRUTINEERING:** All competitor machines, back protector and helmets must be presented for scrutineering after rider has signed on. Scrutineering will be completed at 9.20am.
- **LATE COMPETITORS:** A competitor who presents themselves to sign on and have machines scrutineered late, will be at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course as to whether they are able to compete or not. A late fee will apply of \$10.00.
- **MACHINES:** All machines entered in a meeting held by Central Coast Junior Motorcycle Club inc. must comply with the GCR's for Competition. Noise testing will apply and should you fail you will not be able to compete until the problem is rectified.
- **NO RIDING OF UNREGISTERED MOTORCYCLES AT THE COMPLEX OTHER THAN ON THE TRACK:** This includes the pit area and the car parks. The appointed Officials will exclude riders.
- **RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARENTS/GUARDIANS TO ASSIST IN THE RUNNING OF MEETINGS:**
Every rider MUST have a parent, guardian or another person able to help with the duties of running a meeting. The parent/guardian or other person will be required to nominate the duty of their preference on the roster sheet at signon. If you do not volunteer for a duty, **you will be allocated one.** Parent/guardians or other person will be required to nominate for any of the following duties.

If the parent/guardian or other person refuses to assist, the rider will not be allowed to compete on that day.

1. Sign On
2. Flag Marshal
3. Scrutineering
4. Scoring
5. Bins
6. Water Truck
7. Start Gates
8. Track Preparation
9. Pit Gate/Marshal
10. Canteen Helpers
11. Toilets
12. Setting Up/
Packing Up.

Please remember that Membership for this year will be granted BUT please be warned that admission may be cancelled and not be allowed next year if the Rules on assistance are not followed.

- **PUSHBIKES & SCOOTERS:** Push bikes and scooters of any description are strictly prohibited from the complex.
- **ANIMALS:** Animals are prohibited from the complex. Animals that assist with a person with a disability will be accepted.
- **TROPHIES:** 1st - 2nd and 3rd, Trophies will be awarded as per point score. All other trophies will be awarded to riders who have done 5 point score meetings or at the discretion of the committee.
- **Club Champion:** Class to have a minimum of 6 riders on average for 5 point scores.
- The annual **Junior/Senior Away** Trophies will only be awarded to the riders whom have the best results, compete under the Central Coast Junior Motorcycle Club name and complete 5 point scores at our complex for the year.
- **SANTA BAGS:** To receive a Santa Bag a rider must complete 5 point score meetings, or at the discretion of the committee. Rider must attend Presentation Day to receive the bag.
- **DRESS CODE:** No open footwear pass pit gate.
- **NO SMOKING in the PITS AT ALL.**
- **INJURED RIDERS:** St. Johns to have the final say as to whether an injured rider can continue to compete on the day. No one is allowed on the track under any circumstances.
- **ALCOHOL:** There is to be no alcohol consumed by riders, parents or guardians on ride days. No alcohol in pit area. If you are caught drinking alcohol you will be asked to leave and possibly banned from the club.
- **UNDER 16 YEARS OLD IN PIT AREA:** As per our track license states that any person under the age of 16 years old is not permitted in the pit area unless you are a competitor.
