The AGM is to be held at Ourimbah RSL on the 12th October 2011 at 7.30pm. All members are encouraged to attend and have your say. All positions will be declared open for nomination. A nomination sheet is attached to help the process.

The 17th October is the final date to have your 2011 HONDA/ Australian Junior Dirt Track Championship – 28-30 October 2011 regs in. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED IF LATE AND WITHOUT PAYMENT INCLUDED due to competitors entering and THEN not showing up for the event.

In the mist and rain the riders shined at Somersby on the 24-25th September the club hosted the 2011 Tumut Motorcycle Accessories NSW Junior Dirt Track Championships.

The meeting started on a sad note with the word spreading about the tragic death of Gary Moon a sidecar competitor on Friday night at Townsville starting the meeting with a minute silence in respect to Gary and his family.

The build up to this meeting had been difficult with July and August being the wettest months since 1988, but all was put in place for the riders and spectators to witness what looked like being history in the making since 2000 when Casey Stoner won 30 from 33 races at a championship at Allen Park. Sean McLellan seem to be the rider to beat right from practice taking 9 race to 9 wins with the only obstacle to beat him was the weather.

With 16 championship classes, 3 support classes, 24 practice and 72 races on the Saturday were run in wet conditions and in the afternoon the mist rolled in. With this, all the junior riders showed what an outstanding pool of talent there is in dirt track with most of the riders achieving there personal goals.

Ashley McCormick is on a mission to attend the Night of Championships being the first to win in 5 different disciplines and collected her 4th discipline on the weekend. Boyd Hollis sacrificed a spot on the podium when involved in a 3 rider fall and did not jump back on his bike but went to the aid of another competitor involved. This showed great sportsmanship and is to be congratulated.

Luckily we were able to complete 3 rounds on the Saturday. With the storm and rain over Saturday night it did not look promising for Sunday. Arriving at the track on Sunday morning and a quick walk around the track, the meeting seemed to be a go ahead until the sky opened leaving no other choice, but to cancel the day. Presentation was held and congratulations to all competitors who bravely weathered the conditions. Look forward to seeing you at our (dry) 2011 Honda Australian Junior Dirt Championships on the 28-30th October.

The King of Nepean Meeting in only 2nd year after a long break has now turned into a must be there meeting. The spectators were treated to some competitors showing some of the best dirt track racing. The finals had everyone on their toes watching these riders compete for the King of Nepean. Our riders performed great up against the home track avenges of the local riders. Congratulations to the club on a great meeting.

A few of our senior riders ventured down to ACT Motorcycle Club in Canberra for the 2011 Australian Senior Dirt Track Championships. There were some great results from Michael Blair who didn't need to wash his front number plate until the finals finishing 3rd in the U19. Brodie Nowlan was also on fire until a bit of bad luck in the finals. These 1 race finals sure can make or break a rider's weekend. Peter Smith had to win the repechage to finish 7th in the final of the U19's and David Smith lined up in some of the hardest heats only to just miss out.

Another good meeting with a great circuit is the Far South Coast Cup at Candelo. Three of our riders went down to this meeting and it's a shame more didn't attend. Sean McLellan with his racing being outstanding. Peter Smith doing some of his best riding taking a first in the pro-lites and one of our newest riders Michael Knight is showing great potential in this early stage of his riding.

Parramatta Dirt Track Spectacular will be no more. Due to the lack of entries the Parramatta City Raceway has pulled the pin on any further dirt track meeting. The entries were 41 and if the people who rang late had been 2 days earlier it would have gone ahead. Entries need to be put into place on the dates requested to make organising easier on the promoting club or venues. It a shame that a meeting under lights in the middle of Sydney could not go ahead even after the negotiations for a cheaper entry and 1 extra pass.

Coaching Clinics: Due to no response from one of our coaches and Paul Caslick being out of action the committee has asked MNSW to organise one coaching clinic for the club. You will need to reserve you place by filling in the form on the MNSW website under competitor's information and sending it back to them. The cost is \$30.00 per rider. These fill in quickly, so don't hesitate and ring to reserve your place.

This meeting has been cancelled twice due to the wet weather and was planned to be held on the 9th November only to be informed by one of the speedway members that it has been moved to the Kurri Speedway. **At no stage was the club committee informed of this and after emails with no**

response and phone calls was told that the trustees of this event no longer wish to hold this meeting at Allen Park MVRG. It is disappointing that the speedway members of the club were not taken into account and this meeting after 8 years or so the trustees see fit to move Roy Thomson Memorial without any notification whatsoever.
